Beakes Presents to the Legislature



Ben Beakes, executive director of the West Virginia Association of Health Plans, presented to the WV legislature on Monday, August 26th on the successful rollout of the prior authorization

online portal. The prior authorization portal became effective on July 1st and required all providers to submit prior authorizations online.

The WVAHP spent the first half of the year preparing and training the Medicaid provider groups on the rollout in hopes of avoiding delays or confusion. Memos were sent to nine provider groups so they could communicate effectively with their members. WVAHP also hosted a webinar where more than 300 medical professionals registered to attend. The training session and Q&A that followed was well received by those who participated. The webinar can be viewed by visiting ahpwv.com.

Since the portal opened, the managed care organizations have had no major concerns or problems. However, they will continue to evaluate needs for flexibility.
