Prior Authorization Webinar

During the 2023 West Virginia legislative session, SB267 passed and was signed into law. This legislation made several changes to prior authorization processes, including submissions to insurer's online portal. This new mandate will begin July 1, 2024, and requires providers to submit all prior authorizations electronically.

As a follow up to a memo sent to the provider associations in April on the changes to prior authorization, the members of the WVAHP (Aetna Better Health of WV, The Health Plan, and UniCare Health Plan of WV) hosted a webinar for the provider community. The training session focused on two areas: 1) prior authorization submissions through insurer's online portal, and 2) provider gold carding. Gold carding allows providers to be exempt from submitting prior authorizations if certain standards are met. The webinar was well received with over 200 healthcare professionals in attendance.
